## Selection Criteria and Scheme of Examination for the post of **LOWER DIVISION CLERK** for LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS

### 1. General

- 1.1 The promotion to the post of Lower Division Clerk shall be through a process of Computer Based Test (CBT) & Skill Test in Typing on Computer.
- 1.2 For CBT (Objective-MCQ), there will be 100 questions carrying 01 mark each (Total 100 marks).
- 1.3 The Time for Computer Based Test (Objective-MCQ) is of 60 minutes.
- 1.4 To qualify the examination, the candidate must secure at least 40% of marks in Objective Paper. Only those candidates, who obtain qualifying marks in the Objective CBT Paper, shall be eligible for appearing in the Skill Test in Typing on Computer.
- 1.5 There is no negative marking for any wrong answer in CBT examination.
- 1.6 The Skill Test in Typing on Computer will be qualifying in nature, but merit list for selection will be drawn on the basis of marks secured in the Objective CBT Paper. Only those candidates who qualify Skill Test will be considered for inclusion in the merit list.
- 1.7 In CBT (Objective-MCQ) Paper, the questions in Section-A will be in concerned language and for Section-B and Section-C, the questions will be in bilingual (Hindi & English).
- 1.8 In the event of tie in scores in the total marks in Objective (CBT– MCQ) Paper, the following factors will be taken in order of preference in deciding the merit:
  - (a) Seniority in the feeder post.

### **3. Skill Test/Computer Typing Test Syllabus Pattern:**

Skill Test norms on Computer:

English Typing @35wpm Hindi/Sanskrit Typing @ 30w.p.m

(Time allowed in 10 minutes)

(35w.p.m. and 30 w.p.m. correspond to 10,500 KDPH and 9000 KDPH respectively on an average of 5 key depressions for each word)

### **4. The General Instructions are as under :-**

- (a) Candidates are directed to attend 1 hour before to the venue i.e. examination centre.
- (b) Candidates are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets/mobile phones.
