Central Sanskrit University, Delhi and Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, Mumbai Memorandum of Understanding



This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 23 day of December, 2023

The Central Sanskrit University, Delhi, established under Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 passed by the Parliament, hereinafter referred to as the CSU, represented by its Registrar or any of its officers authorised by the Vice Chancellor, CSU



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Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, Mumbai, established in 1958, and decreed as 'Institute of National Importance' by the Parliament of India, IITB has emerged as one of the top technical universities in the world in the field of engineering education and research, having its registered office at Powai, Mumbai - 400076 hereinafter referred as "IITB" represented by its director

This MOU witnesses as under: -

- Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate disseminate and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Non-Formal Sanskrit Education (NFSE) activity.
- And whereas for implementing its NFSE activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and general public within its reach, through NFSE Cell along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.
- 3. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements and material for conducting the prescribed courses in this NFSE Cell:
 - a. Trained Sanskrit Teacher
 - b. Prescribed monthly remuneration to be paid by CSU. (In addition to his duties in the allotted Cell, s/he may be required to teach the learners at any other nearby Centre/Centres if required).
 - c. Reading material for the learners
 - d. Prescribed guidelines for NFSE
 - e. Conducting examination at the end of academic session and awarding certificate/diploma to the successful candidates.
- 4. And whereas, the CSU will undertake Sanskrit education for Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language and Diploma in Sanskrit language of the duration of one year each for the learners in NFSE Cell. Learners enrolled in the Cell will be required to deposit Rs.500 as Enrolment/Registration fees (annual) and an additional Rs 500 each (plus postage charges) for reading material/textbooks prescribed for each course namely Certificate and Diploma. Students may directly deposit Online payment to CSU.
- 5. And whereas IITB will provide the facilities and extend support as under
 - a. Suitable arrangements for functioning of NFSE Cell, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity etc.

- b. Nominating a faculty member as authorised officer to coordinate functioning of the Cell. S/He will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted as per the provisions prescribed in the guidelines for NFSE.
- c. Publicising the Sanskrit learning courses of CSU in non-formal mode and also making arrangement of the same at its Cell.
- 6. And whereas in any matter concerning the NFSE Cell or any issue arising in conducting the courses, the same will be resolved jointly by the authorised officers of CSU and IITB.

The duration of the MoU is 12 months i.e., from August 2022 to July 2023.

Now, therefore, in witness whereof, this MOU is executed and signed by the officers of CSU and IITB.
