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Memorandum of Understanding

56-57, Institutional Area Tais Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 22nd day of November 2022

Between

The Central Sanskrit University, Delhi, established under Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 passed by the Parliament, hereinafter referred to as the CSU, represented by its Registrar or any of its officers authorised by the Vice Chancellor, CSU


And

SHRI RAMDEOBABA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MANAGEMENT. NAGPUR hereinafter referred as RCOEM

represented by its Principal

This MOU witnesses as under-

- 1. Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate disseminate and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Non Formal Sanskrit Education (NFSE) activity.
 - 2. And whereas for implementing its NFSE activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its



students/staff and general public within its reach, through NFSE Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.

- 3. And whereas, pursuant to the proposal submitted by RCOEM, Nagpur for running of NFSE Centre, the CSU intends to collaborate with it for opening of the NFSE Centre in its premises and sign the MOU therefore.
- 4. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements and material for conducting the prescribed courses in this NFSE Centre
 - a. Trained Sanskrit Teacher.
 - b. Prescribed monthly remuneration to be paid by CSU. (In addition to his duties in the allotted Centre, he may be required to teach the learners at any other nearby Centre/Centres if required).
 - c. Reading material for the learners
 - d. Prescribed guidelines for NFSE
 - e. Conducting examination at the end of academic session and awarding certificate/diploma to the successful candidates.
- 5. And whereas, the CSU will undertake Sanskrit education for Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language and Diploma in Sanskrit language of the duration of one year each for the learners in NFSE Centre. Learners enrolled in the Centre will be required to deposit prescribed Registration fee to the CSU.
- 6. And whereas RCOEM, Nagpur will provide the facilities and extend support as under:
 - a. Suitable arrangements for functioning of NFSE Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity etc.
 - b. Nominating a faculty member as authorised officer to coordinate functioning of the Centre. He will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted as per the provisions prescribed in the guidelines for NFSE.
 - c. Publicising the Sanskrit learning courses of CSU in non formal mode and also making arrangement of the same at its Centre.
- 7. And whereas in any matter concerning the NFSE Centre or any issue arising in conducting the courses, the same will be resolved jointly by the authorised officers of CSU and RCOEM, Nagpur.
- 8. This MOU will be valid initially for one academic session and may be extended mutually. Now, therefore, in witness whereof, this MOU is executed and signed by the officers of CSU and RCOEM, Nagpur.
