Selection Criteria and Scheme of Examination for the post of **STENOGRAPHER - GRADE II**

1. General

- 1.1 The selection to the post of Stenographer-Grade II shall be through a process of Computer Based Test (CBT Objective) & Skill Test in Stenography and Typing on Computer.
- 1.2 For CBT(Objective-MCQ), there will be 100 questions carrying 01 mark each (Total 100 marks).
- 1.3 There is no negative marking for any wrong answer in CBT examination.
- 1.4 The Time for Computer Based Test of (Objective-MCQ) is of 60 minutes.
- 1.5 To qualify the examination, the candidate must secure at least 40% of marks in the Objective CBT Paper. Only those candidates, who obtain qualifying marks in the Objective CBT Paper, shall be eligible for appearing in the Skill Test in Stenography.
- 1.6 The Skill Test in Stenography will be qualifying in nature, but merit list for selection will be drawn on the basis of marks secured in the Objective CBT Paper. Only those candidates who qualify Skill Test will be considered for inclusion in the merit list.
- 1.7 In Objective (CBT-MCQ) Paper, the questions in Section-A will be in concerned language and for Section-B and Section-C, the questions will be in bilingual (Hindi & English).
- 1.8 In the event of tie in scores in the total marks in Objective (CBT-MCQ) Paper, the following factors will be taken in order of preference in deciding the merit:
 - (a) Percentage of marks in the 12th class, which is the minimum qualification to apply for the post.
 - (b) Age factor comes in scene (elder candidate will be given preference).

3. Skill test in Stenography

- 3.1 Candidates who obtain the qualifying marks in the Objective (CBT) Paper will be called for the Skill Test (stenography test).
- 3.2 The candidates will be given one dictation for 10 minutes in English / Hindi at the speed of 80 w.p.m. for the post of Stenographer Grade II. The matter will have to be transcribed on computer only. The evaluation of transcription will be done electronically only. The transcription time is as follows:-
 - Stenographer Grade II 50 minutes (English) and 65 Minutes (Hindi)
- 3.3 If the candidates do not indicate the medium of stenography test in Application Form, the University will consider English as the medium of stenography test for such candidates.
- 3.4 There is no exemption from skill test for any category of candidates.
- 4. Candidates who opt to take the Stenography Test in Hindi will be required to learn English Stenography and vice versa after their appointment. Candidates have to work as English / Hindi stenographers as per the functional requirement of the University irrespective of the medium of Skill Test of candidate during the examination.
- 5. VH candidates will be required to transcribe the matter in 75 minutes for English Shorthand or in 100 minutes for Hindi Shorthand for the post of Stenographer Grade II.
- 6. The skill test will be held at the University Headquarters or at other Centre(s) as may be decided by the University.

7. The General Instructions are as under:-

- (a) Candidates are directed to attend 1 hour before to the venue i.e. examination centre.
- (b) Candidates are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets/mobile phones.
- (c) If any candidate is found to possess any electronic gadgets any other means of wireless communication in the working or switched off mode, his/her candidature shall be cancelled forthwith and he/she will be debarred from the examination.
- (d) No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the examination.
- (e) Any other necessary instructions will be given in Hall ticket/Admit card.
