## NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an institution of higher learning as a deemed-to-be-university.
2. And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government vide its Notification No.9-28/2000-U. 3 dated 07.05.2002, on the advice of UGC, had declared 'Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan', New Delhi consisting of its eight multi-campuses located at Lucknow, Allahabad, Jaipur, Sringeri, Trichur, Puri, Jammu \& Garil (Kangra, Himachal Pradesh) as an "Institution Deemed to be University", subject to a review after five years.
3. And whereas, the Central Government vide Notification No. 9-28/2000-U. 3 dated 01.01.2009, on the advice of the UGC, extended the status of Deemed to be University of 'Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan', New Delhi for a further period of five years i.e. upto 06.05.2012.
4. And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, vide Notification No. 9-28/2000-U. 3 dated 30.06.2009, on the advice of the UGC, permitted 'Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan', New Delhi to bring the Bhopal and Mumbai Campus under its ambit as constituent teaching units.
5. And further whereas, the functioning of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi was reviewed by UGC through its Expert Committee during 28-30th January, 2017. The Report of the Committee was considered by the Commission in its $521^{\text {st }}$ meeting (Item No.2.03) held on $22^{\text {nd }}$ February, 2017 and the following resolution was passed:
"Considered and approved with the condition that the deficiencies pointed out, if any, would be rectified and suggestions given by Expert Committee would be implemented within a period of six months and the compliance report would be submitted alongwith documentary proof to UGC."
6. And whereas, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi submitted its compliance report which was again considered by the Commission in its $537^{\text {th }}$ meeting (Item

No.2.04) held on $10^{\text {th }}$ December, 2018 and recommended for extension of Deemed to be University status to Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi from 07.05.2012 onwards.
7. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the UGC, do hereby extend the Deemed to be University status to Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi from 07.05.2012 onwards with the condition that the Institution Deemed to be University shall comply with the suggestions given by the UGC Expert Committee, from time to time. This extension is further to condition that all the terms and conditions that were stipulated in the earlier Notifications of this Ministry shall continue to be adhered by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi.
