



Reservation Policy for Admission

The Central Sanskrit University is one of the prestigious universities when it comes to the content and quality of education in India. All the students across the country want to get admission in this University. The reservation policies for admission are as follows.

RESERVATION

- (1) Scheduled Caste (SC) = 15% of total intake in each course
- (2) Scheduled Tribe (ST) = 7 ½ % of total intake in each course
- (3) Other Backward Classes (OBC) = 27% of total intake in each course
- (4) Economically Weaker Section (EWS) = 10% other than total intake in each course
- (5) Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) quota = 3% of total intake
(1% each for the persons with low vision or blindness,
hearing impaired and locomotors disability or cerebral).
- (6) Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel reservation (CW Category)
= 5% of the seats in each course.
- (7) Foreign Nationals = 5% seats in each course in Departments/
Colleges for admission under reservation.

Note : In case of non-availability of reserved category candidates the seats will be filled up from the General Category candidates as per the directives of UGC/GOI
