MINUTES OF THE IQAC ONLINE MEETING



AT THE HEAD QUARTERS OFFICE OF THE UNIVERSITY, NEW DELHI



(a) Recommended to conduct periodically various activities for Sanskrit teachers, non-Sanskrit teachers and non-teaching staff for effective implementation of

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Saral Manak samskrutam as medium of instruction, administration as well as management.

(b) Also recommended that Prof. Y. S. Ramesh of Siksha Shastra department to coordinate and submit a proposal on student exchange programme, if students of a campus are unable to participate in the various programmes conducted by their respective campuses, such students may be selected under this exchange programme in between campuses for example : Only Kerala students of the Guruvayoor Campus will come and stay at Jaipur Campus and vice versa and Karnataka students of Sringeri Campus to Bhopal Campus and vice versa for three to seven days to gain first-hand knowledge of the food habits, culture, dress style, life style, folk arts and regional language on reciprocal basis. In this way the concept of “Ek Bharat, Samarth Bharat” can be achieved. A teacher may accompany the students group as the guide/escort for this purpose and travel along with the students in the means of transportation facility provided. In this context, no special provision of transportation and accommodation can be provided to escorting teacher.


