Memorandum of Understanding

As part of a constant endeavour to promote mutual understanding and international scientific research, an agreement is hereby entered into on cooperation between Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and Shree Somnath Sanskrit University, Veraval, India.

1. SCOPE OF MoU:

- Academic exchange in the areas of lecture series, cultural and religious studies, Sanskrit and Indian Knowledge System,
- Access to library facilities and manuscript resources through cooperation between the Central Library, SSSU and the Library of CSU, New Delhi
- Exchange of researchers, teaching staff and students,
- Conducting joint research projects,
- Organisation of international colloquia,
- Regular exchange of documentary publications and teaching materials.

2. GENERAL MATTERS:

- A project may only be taken up once its funding has been secured. No financial obligations result from this agreement for either of the two parties unless mutual consent has been given.
- The details of exchange of students, researchers and teaching staff shall be determined by both the parties on a project-by-project basis. Both parties declare their willingness to give their guests from the partner university every possible support during their stay.

3. DURATION & TERMINATION:

The agreement will come into effect from the date of most recent signature and is entered into for a period of 5 years. Thereafter it shall be automatically extended for an additional period of 5 years unless either party

provides written notice to terminate the agreement a minimum of one year prior to the date of expiry. Either party may terminate the cooperation provided that notice is given at least six months in advance. Ongoing projects and exchanges may be completed before a termination becomes valid. Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and Shree Somnath Sanskrit University, Veraval shall execute this agreement to the best of their knowledge and ability.

4. REPRESENTATION:

Representatives for regular co-ordination and functionality of this MoU shall be as under: (a.) Central Sanskrit University (CSU), New Delhi will be represented by its Registrar, Central Sanskrit University & (b.) Shree Somnath Sanskrit University, Veraval will be represented by its Head, Post Graduate Section of the University.


5. CONFIDENTIALITY:

Confidentiality Both parties acknowledge that any information disclosed by or on behalf of any of the parties which is not in the public domain is confidential and may not be used or disclosed to any other party (whether before or after the termination of this MOU) for any reason whatsoever save as may be strictly necessary for the due and effectual rendering of the services, as required by this MOU and/or agreements made thereunder. Any data exchanged/shared between the parties for joint research/supervision will not be transferred to third party without consent of the Universities.

The provisions of this Clause shall survive the expiration or termination of this MOU for a period of three subsequent academic years. However confidential information in the nature of intellectual property rights, trade secrets and/or such confidential information which needs to be protected/kept confidential owing to applicable law(s) shall be kept confidential in perpetuity by the receiving party.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

It is the intention of the institutions that all research derived from the collaborative efforts of the two parties will be the joint property of both the parties, proportionate to the parties' respective contribution.

7. AMENDMENT TO MoU:

No amendment to this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing jointly by the parties hereto or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment to this MoU.

8. ARBITRATION:


In the event of difference disputes arising between the parties in respect of any matter arising out of and relating to this MoU, such dispute/difference shall, in the first instance, be resolved amicably by mutual consultation within 45 days of the reference of disputes by either party.

In the event of any dispute or differences between the parties hitherto, such differences shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation. Where it could not be resolved so, then it shall be referred to arbitration of three arbitrators, one to be appointed by each of the parties. The two arbitrators shall appoint the Third Arbitrator (Umpire) mutually who shall preside over the proceedings. The decision of the said arbitrators shall be final and binding on both the parties. The award of the arbitration is binding on the parties unless appealed against it in a Competent Court within the period of limitation.
