The Examination Section of Central Sanskrit University is assigned to execute a project on प्राचीनभारतीयशिक्षायां मूल्याङ्कनपद्धतयः (Evaluation Methods in Ancient Indian Education). The Examination Section will complete the project to explore the Evaluation Methods in Ancient Indian Education in the light of the recommendations of NEP 2020. For this project, applications are invited for the posts of Two Post-Doctoral Fellowship. The fellowship is initially sanctioned for the duration of 12 months which is purely temporary and may be extended for another year based on performance and the availability of funds.
