As per the advertisement dated 23/06/2025 published vide Advt. No. 03/2025, the guidelines and syllabus for the recruitment test to be conducted for the engagement of Young Professionals are as following-

#### **Guidelines for the Test:**

- Offline Test (Pen-paper mode) will be held in the designated centres.
- Candidates have to attend two question papers – Paper I & Paper II.

**Paper I – 80 MCQs (Common for All Candidates)**

**Paper II A / B / C – 20 MCQs (Category-specific)**

- Candidates applying in the concerned category have to attend **Paper II A / B / C** respectively.

**Paper IIA - Academic related Research & Planning**

**Paper IIB - Management related Works**

**Paper IIC - Process Evaluation & Design and Administration**

- Candidates have to attend 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) each carrying 4 marks. Maximum marks will be 400.
- There will be **No Negative Marking for incorrect answers.**
- All MCQs are compulsory.
- Questions are Bilingual – Hindi & English.
- Questions regarding Language Proficiency will be in the respective language only.

**Paper I – 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM (90 min.)**

**Paper II A/B/C – 11:45 AM onwards (20 min. per category - A, B & C)**

- Candidates have to select the correct answer by filling the OMR Sheet within the given time period.
