Paper IIB - Management related Works

Paper IIC - Process Evaluation & Design and Administration

- Candidates have to attend 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) each carrying 4 marks. Maximum marks will be 400.
- There will be No Negative Marking for incorrect answers.
- All MCQs are compulsory.
- Questions are Bilingual Hindi & English.
- Questions regarding Language Proficiency will be in the respective language only.
