Scholarship Opportunity to study Latin, Ancient Greek, and Western Humanities (Accademia Vivarium Novum, Rome, Italy)

Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and **Accademia Vivarium Novum, Rome** are collaboratively creating an opportunity for CSU Students for learning Ancient Greek and Latin, the western classical literature, and philosophy, under the mutual agreement established through the MoU dated 4th July 2025.

As announced in the notification of the three-day seminar titled "Classical Languages and the Western Humanities" (August 1–3, 2025), CSU is going to facilitating the CSU students to apply at the Accademia Vivarium Novum in Rome, Italy.

For the academic year 2025-2026, up to two CSU students between the ages of 16 and 24 will be selected for the **Nine-Month Residential Program at the** *Accademia Vivarium Novum* in **Rome, Italy**. The selected CSU students will be awarded a **full scholarship**, which includes:

•	Round-trip travel to Italy	(covered by CSU)
•	Visa expenses and travel medical insurance	(covered by CSU)
•	Accommodation, meals, and medical costs in Italy	(covered by AVN)
•	Course fees, books, and other study materials	(covered by AVN)

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Must be enrolled in a CSU program or affiliated with CSU.
- 2. Age between 16 and 24 years (strictly enforced).
- 3. Must demonstrate academic excellence, with a strong knowledge of Sanskrit and good proficiency in English.
- 4. Must hold a valid passport by 15th August 2025.

 - Character Certificate issued by the Director or the Principal
 - Approval Letter of the Parents or Guardian

The last date for submitting the online application and documents to Accademia Vivarium Novum, Italy is 10th August 2025. The selection process will be carried out by the

Accademia Vivarium Novum in accordance with the guidelines published on their official website. The final selection and approval of candidates will be subject to the joint discretion of the Vice Chancellor, Central Sanskrit University and the President, Accademia Vivarium Novum.

The 9-month program will start on 28th September 2025 and end on 21st June 2026. The selected students be granted an academic break from their enrolled CSU course for the 2025–26 session and permitted to complete their academic program at CSU upon return from AVN.

Appendix: Guidelines for Motivation Letter Submission

As part of the application process, all candidates are required to submit a **Motivation Letter** (of up to 2 pages, Times New Roman, 12 pt). This letter should be written in English and must be original and authentic. Please note that **submissions generated using AI will be negatively considered**, as the selection committee employs strict AI-detection measures.

The Motivation Letter should introduce you in a clear and detailed manner and explain your reasons for applying to the program. In addition to your personal motivation, the letter must include the following information:

- Full name
- Date and place of birth
- Current school or university affiliation
- Duration of study in Latin, Greek, or Sanskrit
- Authors and works you have read
- Other academic pursuits and primary interests outside of school
